## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR TENURE OF REPS:

- 1. Should possess the minimum qualifications for the position as stated in the QS for REPS
  - a) education requirements
  - b) experience requirements
  - c) civil service eligibility
- 2. At least a master's or equivalent degree or professional degree
- 3. Minimum average workload for every six (6) months of 12 units for SG 15 and above or 9 units for SG < 15 for the past 3 years;
  - or rating of not lower than VS for the past 3 years for REPS who are evaluated based on Performance Evaluation Standards System\* (\*until Dec. 2004, assuming that the new REPS Service Record will be applied beginning Jan. 2002)
- 4. Sole or lead authorship of a refereed journal article (local or international) or equivalent output as follows:
  - a. two policy papers/monographs/technical bulletins/training manuals
  - b. two oral presentations in scientific meetings
  - c. three poster papers/packaged slide/transparency/video program/power point presentations/computer programs/UPLB annual reports

four feature or in-depth articles in popular publications

- e. six unit annual reports/database for CU annual reports
- f. eight leaflets/brochures/primers
- g. current awareness (4 for annual; 8 for bi-annual)

For SG <15, co-authorship is allowed, provided that the output is doubled

## Documents required for submission:

- 1. graduate degree certificate/diploma
- 2. transcript of records
- 3. UPLB Form 67 (Faculty/REPS Service Record) for the last 3 years
- 4. Proof of publications or equivalent output
- 5. Justification from the immediate supervisor including, among others, the important contributions of the recommended personnel to the unit
- 6. Staff development plan of the unit
- 7. Curriculum vitae
